# Opening of Chemnitz Technical Center

Mori Seiki Co., Ltd. has opened the Chemnitz Technical Center in Saxony, Germany. An open house event for customers is being held on February 11th and 12th.

The Chemnitz Technical Center is located in Stolberg, which is approximately 20 km south of Chemnitz. The investment amount was 2.3 million euro, and the total floor space is approximately 1,300 m<sup>2</sup>.

Saxony, which is located in the eastern part of Germany, is a prosperous region for the automobile and textile industries. Until now, we have opened five Technical Centers in Stuttgart, Munich, Hamburg, Dusseldorf and Frankfurt. The Chemnitz Technical Center will be the sixth in Germany.

In the past, we used to deliver service and sales to central and eastern parts of Germany from the Munich Technical Center, but because the distance to customers was far compared to other regions, we have built the Chemnitz Technical Center to built stronger relations with our customers and deliver faster service to them.

In the Chemnitz Technical Center, there is a showroom of 560 m<sup>2</sup> where 7 new models including the 5-axis control vertical machining center NMV5000 DCG, and the integrated mill turn center NT4250 DCG/1500SZ are displayed. With these machines, we will be introducing customers to the newest machining technology, as well as providing advice on machining, educating operators, and conducting machining tests. We will do our best to make this technical center a comfortable and useful place for our customers.
