Relocation of the head office of MORI SEIKI (SHANGHAI) CO., LTD.

Mori Seiki Co., Ltd. will relocate the head office in China (MORI SEIKI (SHANGHAI) CO., LTD.) from the present commercial building to a four-storied building that has a showroom and a factory of turnkey. The purpose of this relocation is to provide better customer service in China where the demand is expanding.

Near the new office, there is Shanghai factory of GILDEMEISTER (DMG) that collaborates with Mori Seiki. The new office is very convenient for customers who want to buy machines because there are many showrooms of other Japanese and European machine tool companies around the area.

1. Purpose of this relocation

- (1) We open a new showroom in the office so that customers can observe demonstrations on actual machines.
- (2) We open a NC school to provide better support for customer's engineers and operators.

We provide our staff with training using actual machines and improve their technical skills.

- (3) We provide better customer service by increasing parts inventory, and aim to achieve a parts shipment ratio within 24 hours of over 90%.
- (4) We will do time-study and test cut. We will also establish the turnkey section that handles small turnkey projects several times a month.

2. The outline of the new head office in China

- (1) Structure Ferroconcrete, Four stories on the ground, 9,600 m² (Current office is 1,663 m²)
- (2) 331 Guang Zhong Lu 331 Shanghai, China
- (3) 60 staff members will work there.
