Grand Opening of Emerging Technologies Laboratory

On July 24, DMG MORI CO., LTD. (hereinafter called DMG MORI) opened a facility inside the Tokyo Global Headquarter for the Emerging Technologies Laboratory (hereinafter called the Laboratory) which was launched in January 2017.

Technological innovations and trends such as IoT, Industry 4.0, AI robots, COP22-supported decarbonization, electric vehicle (EV), self-driving, fintech (block chain) and share economy – “the future that is already happening now” - will be norms and seen everywhere in society and industries across the world in the world of 2020 and beyond, and the digital revolution is expected to reach the new stage.

The Laboratory was established to gather and develop human resources who are capable of leading the above-mentioned technological revolution, and providing customers with real customer and social value sought after in the era.

The researchers will be offered high educational standards equivalent to the graduate school at the University of Tokyo and trained to be our advanced technical specialists highly knowledgeable about cutting-edge technologies.

The Laboratory will be a solid basis for DMG MORI’s technical and competitive advantages.
