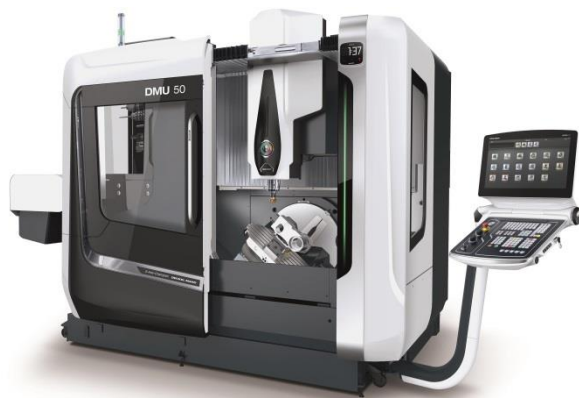
5-axis Technology Study & Research Group - with 70 DMU 50 3rd Generations for 70 customers, on 70th Anniversary!
