DMG MORI Boston Announcement of Grand Opening

DMG MORI Co., Ltd. (hereinafter "DMG MORI") opened DMG MORI Boston in Somerville, Massachusetts, as a new base for R&D as well as sales and service in the Northeastern USA. The opening ceremony was held on April 12th (Tue.), local time, with a ribbon-cutting ceremony attended by Somerville Mayor Katjana Ballantyne, Co-Founder and CEO of Tulip Interfaces^{*1} Natan Linder and CTO Rony Kubat, DMG MORI President Masahiko Mori, and DMG MORI USA President Keiichi Ota.

DMG MORI Boston is located near Boston in the Northeastern USA, a region with rapid economic development. The area is currently home to growing medical, aerospace, and high-tech companies. It is also close to technical universities such as the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and Wentworth Institute of Technology, which, like our Chicago and Davis bases, will play an important role in our focus on digitization and automation research and development. In particular, since the same building will house Tulip Interfaces headquarters^{*1} and showroom, we will work closely with Tulip to further promote the digitization of processes in a practical way using "TULIP"^{*2} to help solve issues at manufacturing sites.

DMG MORI Boston employs approximately 140 employees including the employees of Tulip Interfaces, primarily R&D, application engineers, sales, and service engineers. The latest machines and simulators installed in the Technology Center will be available for viewing by customers as well as for training of customer operators and employees. Furthermore, in order to remain competitive and promote innovative technologies in the future, DMG MORI Boston will hire professionals with knowledge in cutting-edge technologies such as digitization, artificial intelligence, and AM (additive manufacturing).

DMG MORI Boston will not only provide sales and service in the Northeastern USA, but will also serve a new digitization solutions and processes for customers around the world, helping them further improve their productivity.
